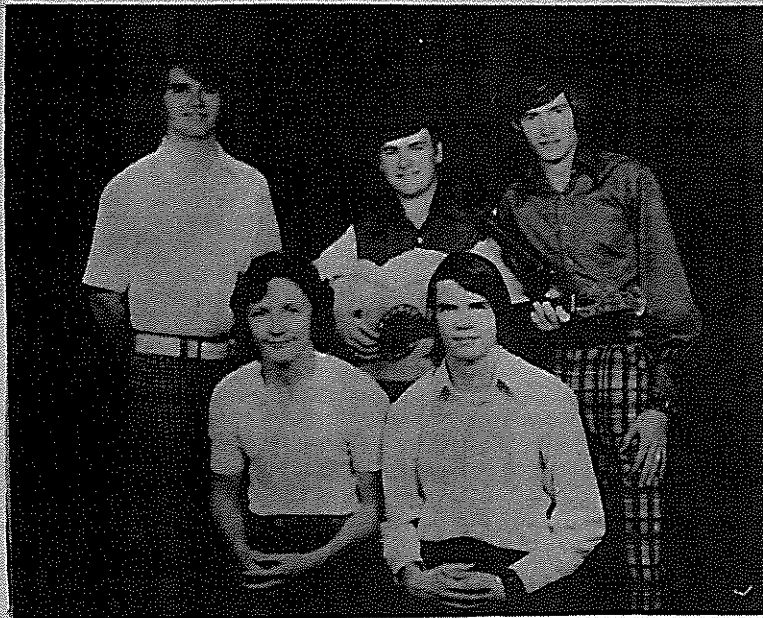

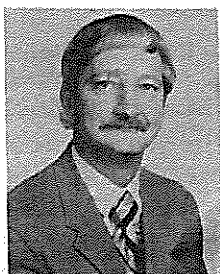

If there is anything or questions you would like to know what we have or planned for during your stay, please feel free to call on me and I shall try to see that it meet your needs.

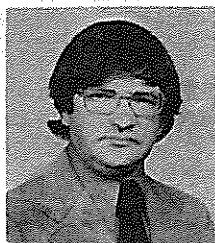

HOST CLUB PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE



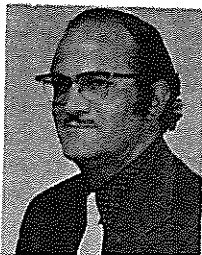

WELCOME TO THE GULF COAST



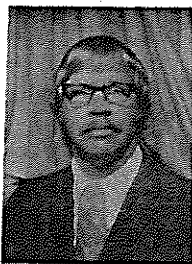

Let's make our D.B.A.D., the greatest and strongest organization of the Deaf and for the Deaf of the South.

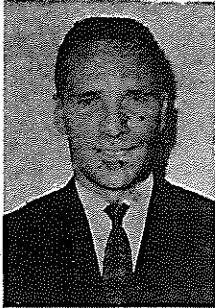
