
Greetings:

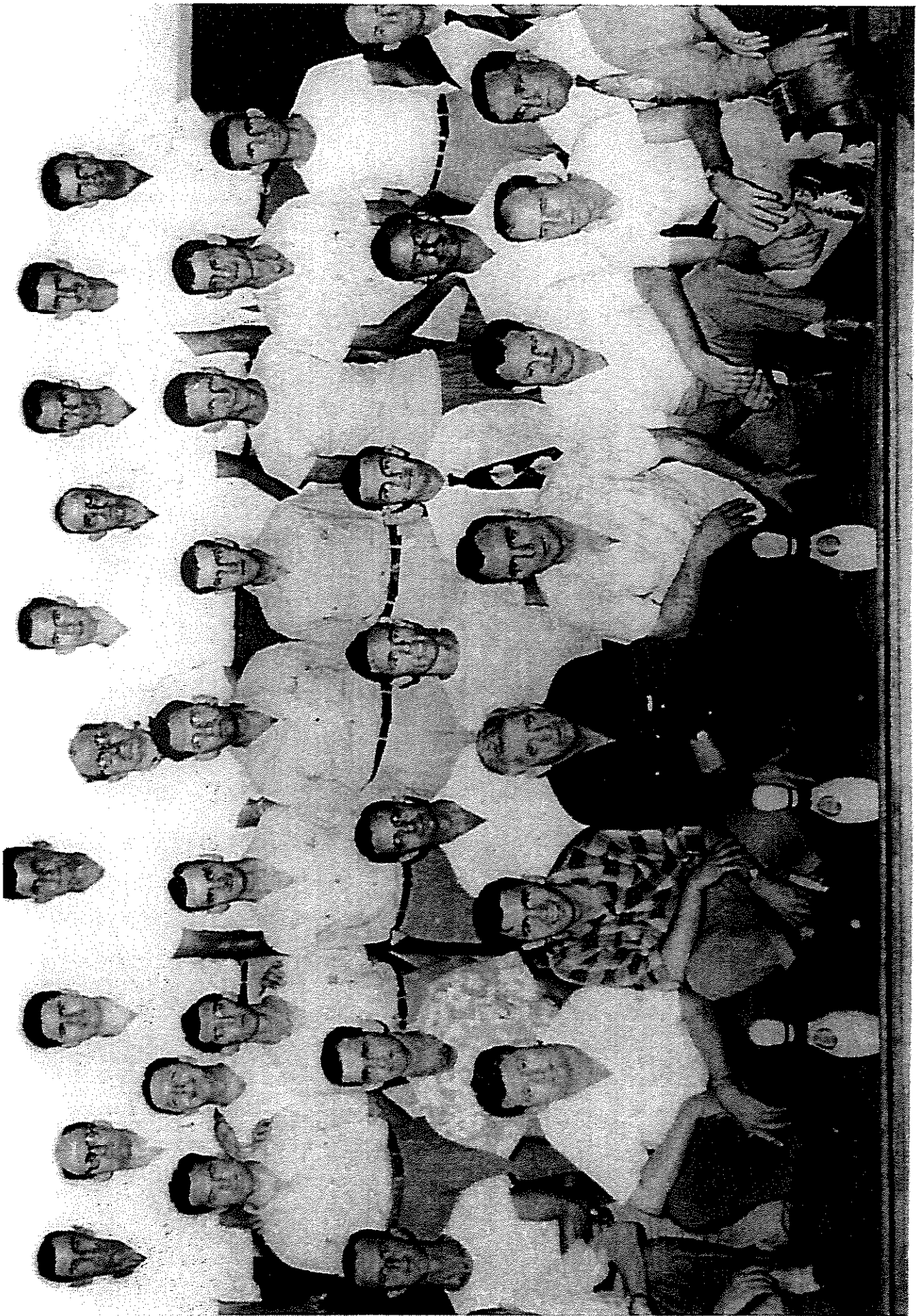

Greetings From the DDWBA President



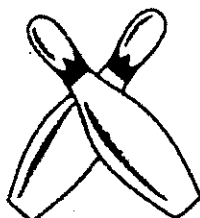

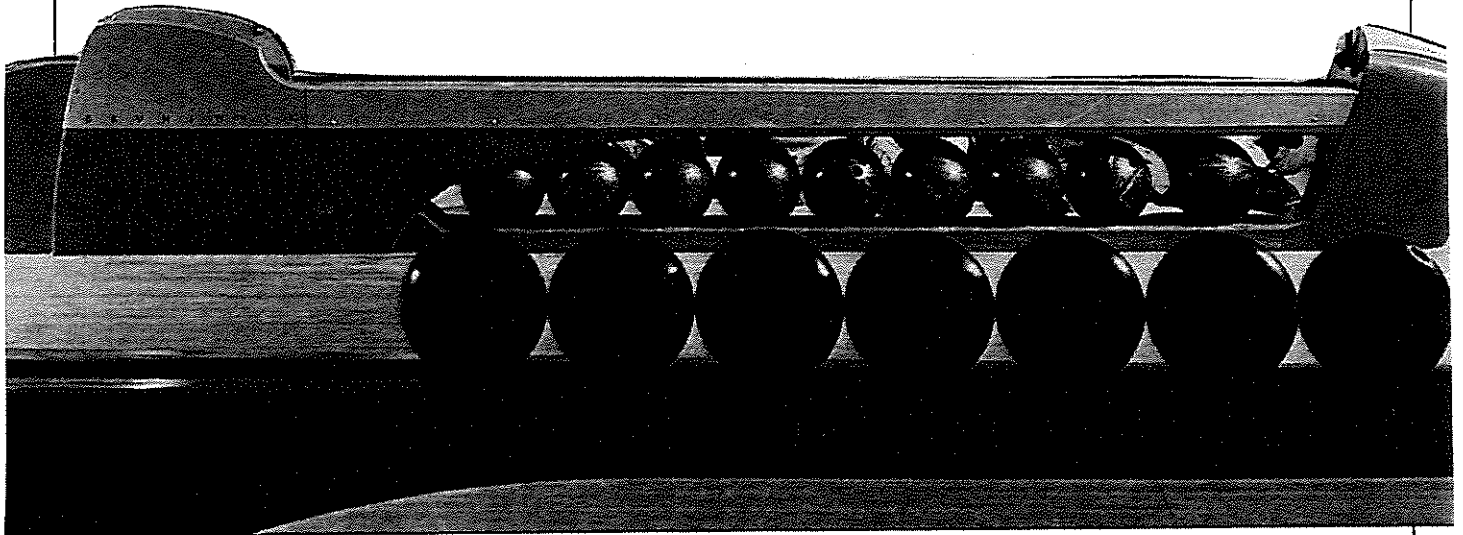

DIXIE HISTORY

1950 to 2000

1950:

DIXIE was “born” and created by a group of bowlers from Georgia, Alabama, and Florida who bowled for “fun” in Jacksonville, Florida. Billy Ethridge, Douglas Hitchcock, and other bowlers came up with the idea of an organization and named it “**DIXIE BOWLING ASSOCIATION OF THE DEAF**” (DBAD).

1951:

First Annual DIXIE in **Atlanta, Georgia** on October 27 & 28, 1951 Chairperson: H.E. Hartsfield
Host: Atlanta Club of the Deaf 6 5-Men teams bowled in the tournament. Atlanta Club of the Deaf “A” team won 1st place: **\$16.00**. Last Place team (6th) got \$2.50. H. Dannis from Birmingham, AL won All Events and received **\$3.00!** Last Place individual (16th) received 25 cents!

1952:

Second Annual DIXIE in **Birmingham, Alabama** on April 19 & 20 Chairperson: Rush Letson
*Deaf History: First transistorized “behind the ear” hearing aid

1953:

Third Annual DIXIE in **Jacksonville, Florida**

*Deaf History: Schools for the Deaf accept both black and white students; The Columbia Institution is renamed “Gallaudet College”

6th Annual DIXIE in **Birmingham, Alabama** on May 4 to 6 Chairperson: Harry C. Walker, Jr.

7th Annual DIXIE in **Louisville, Kentucky** on May 25 to 27 Chairperson: L.B. Warren

8th Annual DIXIE in **Jacksonville, Florida** on May 10 & 11 Chairperson: Todd Hicks

*Deaf History: The National Deaf Bowling Association was organized; Robert Weitbrecht's invention: Acoustic Coupler

15th Annual DIXIE in **Birmingham, Alabama** on May 21 to 23 Chairperson: Howard D. Chapman

Host: Birmingham Club of the Deaf

1966:

16th Annual DIXIE in **Atlanta, Georgia** on May 20 & 21 Chairperson: Charles Watson

*Deaf History: National Technical Institute for the Deaf located in upstate New York; Washoe becomes the first chimp to converse with people in the language of signs
