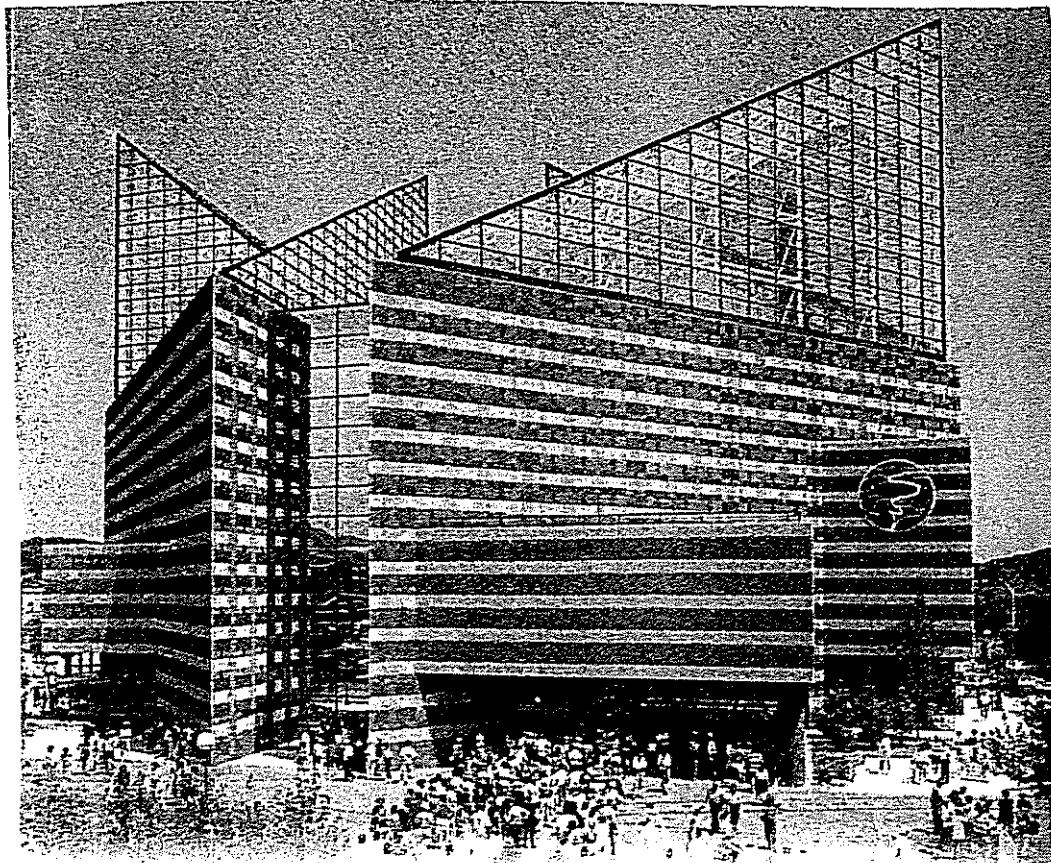





See you all next year May 2008 at WEST VIRGINIA, I beleive this state will be the first time to host it.


