When he was a handsome, young gentleman, he joined the Tri-State Deaf Men Bowling Association and was a member since 1960. He bowled from 1960 to 1974 as the team of Bayou Boys and also played in the leagues of the Louisiana area which was called TRI-State. He was the scorekeeper since 1960 and was an expert in Math. Everyone adored his scorekeeping.

We want to ask all of you to honor the life of a wonderful man, George Fraychineaud, Sr. He was a man with a big heart. He contributed a lot to the Deaf community and he was a natural born leader. He was very creative, a hard worker, and he developed natural skills by doing many different tasks. He created many different fundraising activities to help set up the West Bank Deaf Club, and to help the Catholic church, etc. He also was very involved with the Deaf Mardi Gras Ball. He was humble, yet a natural leader. He faced many challenges/obstacles as a not well-educated Deaf man, but this did not hold him back.

He was a very brave man all the way up until the moment he faced death. He accepted his death with grace. He was a loving husband to my Mother, Dorothy, a teacher to all of his children, grandchildren, and great grandchild. He will be greatly missed. Our hearts grieve, but his spirit will remain with us forever. We are thankful and blessed to have known him. His last words to his family, relatives, and friends were "ILY" as a symbol of love. 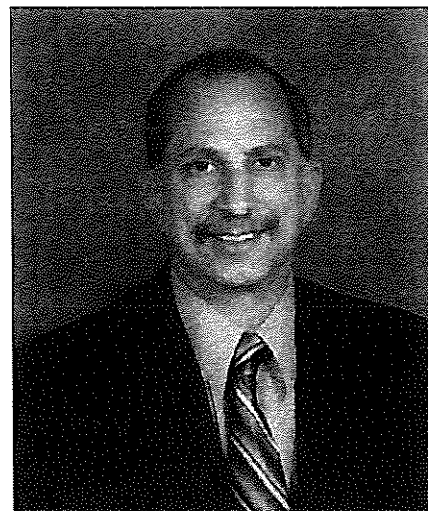
Do not miss our next the 60th annual bowling tournament to be held at Birmingham, AL, the 11th time to be host by that city.
