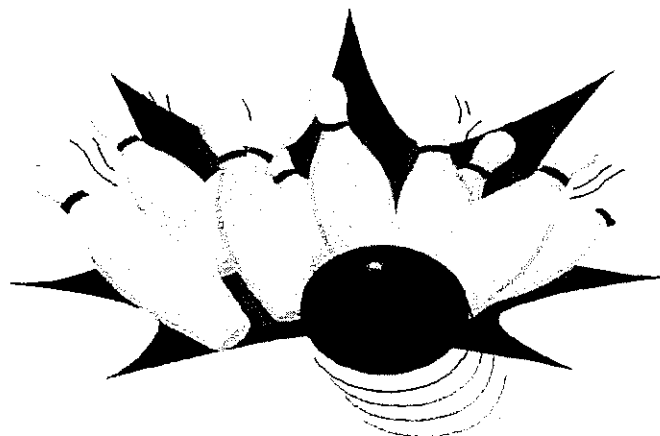

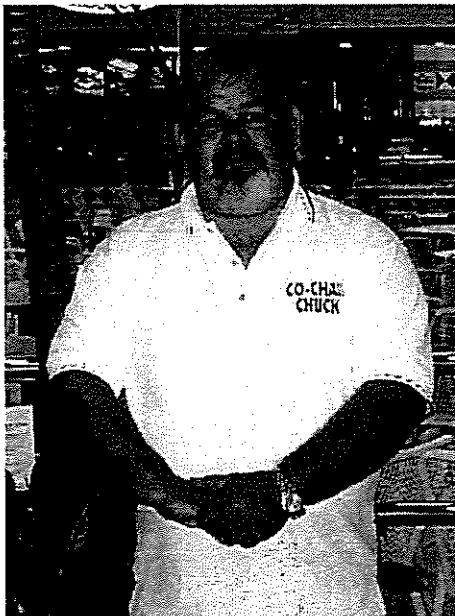
Chairman's Greetings

DIXIE HISTORY

EDITOR'S NOTE: This compilation of Dixie History was taken from the 2000 Dixie Program Book, and is too important to omit, and it should be continued annually with additions. With apologies to Donna Leff as well as my appreciation.--CST

DIXIE was "born" and created by a group of bowlers from Georgia, Alabama, and Florida who bowled for "fun" in Jacksonville, Florida. Billy Ethridge, Douglas Hitchcock, and other bowlers came up with the idea of an organization and named it "**DIXIE BOWLING ASSOCIATION OF THE DEAF**" (DBAD).

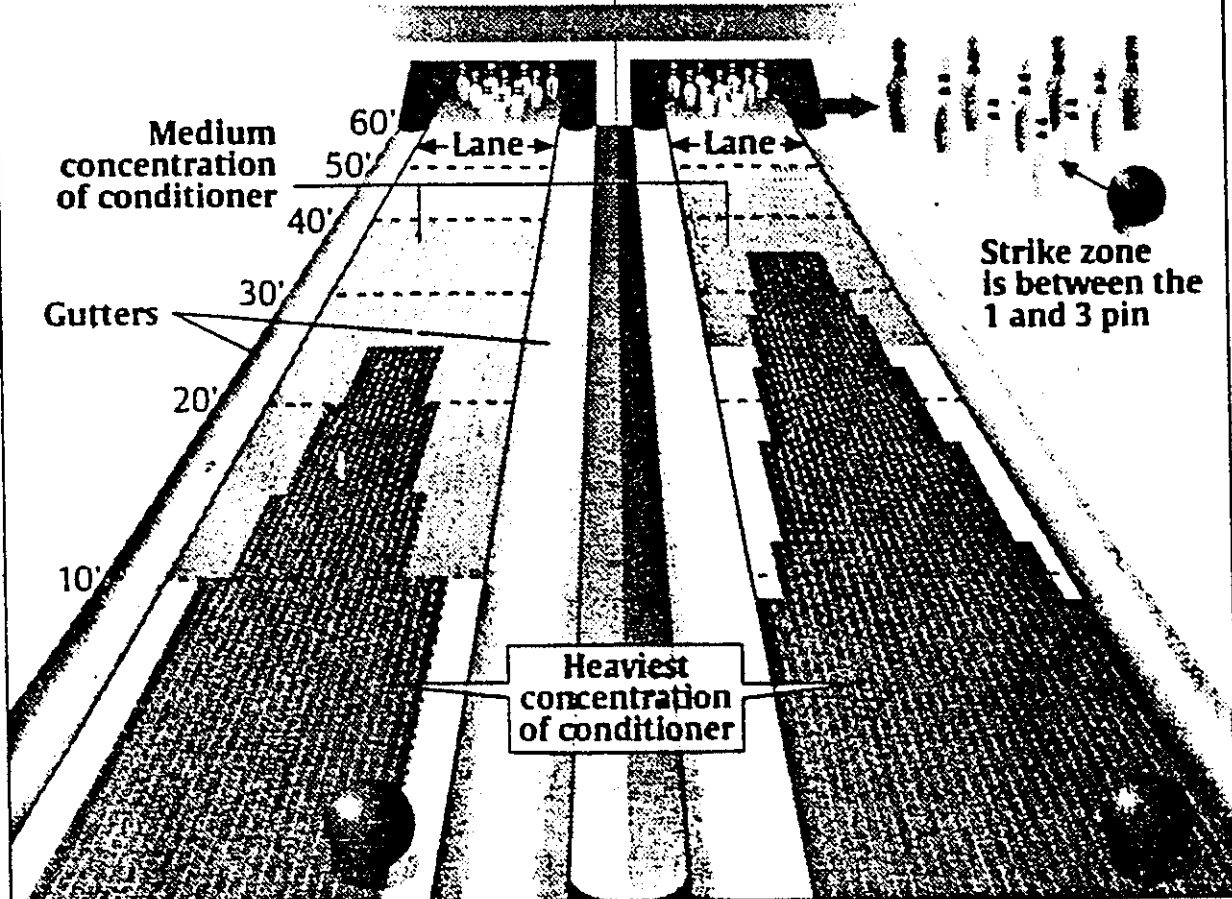

For professional competition, conditioner is spread out more evenly across the lane, requiring greater skill to hit the strike zone.



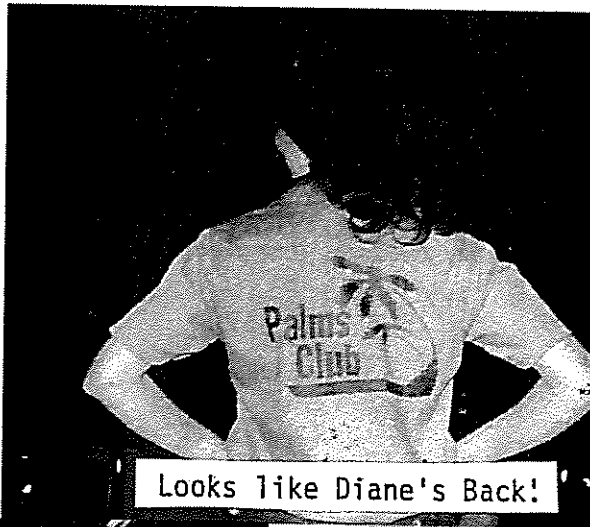

I say good bye for now, pal Pete.

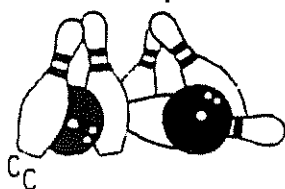

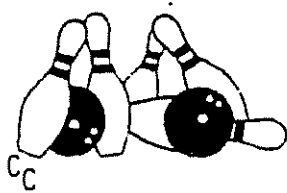
