## CONSTITUTION

### ARTICLE I - NAME AND PURPOSE

SECTION I. This organization shall be known as Dixie Deaf Bowling Association, embracing the states of Alabama, Florida, Georgia, Louisiana, Mississippi, North Carolina, South Carolina, Tennessee, Kentucky, Arkansas, and Virginia.

SECTION II. The Dixie Deaf Bowling Association, hereafter referred to as the Association, is formed for the following purposes:

- (a) To hold, direct, or under its direction and auspices, conduct and manage annually a Dixie Deaf Bowling Association Tournament.
- (b) This tournament shall determine Dixie Champions for: four-man team; five game individual event; and all events. Said tournament is to be governed by the rules and regulations as outlined by the American Bowling Congress (ABC), with such other rules as necessary not in conflict therewith.
- (c) To encourage and foster among its members and those interested in the sport, the spirit of good fellowship.

## BY-LAWS

### ARTICLE I - MEMBERSHIP

SECTION I. All regularly organized bowling teams composed of the male sex from any state in the United States who is deaf, partially deaf, or son(s) or/ husband(s) who can hear, but are familiar with the language of signs and must be members of city clubs or state association and carry active membership cards.

SECTION II. Membership in the Dixie Deaf Bowling Association shall be five dollars (\$5.00) per year payable with entry fee.

### ARTICLE II - ORDER OF BUSINESS

SECTION I. Robert's Rules of Order shall govern the proceedings of all meetings of this Association when not inconsistent with the provisions of this Constitution.

SECTION II. The regular order of business shall be as follows:

1. Call to order
2. Roll call
3. Reading minutes and action thereon
4. Reports of officers in order
5. Reports of committees
6. Unfinished business
7. New business
8. Selection of tournament city
9. Election of officers
10. Announcements subject to approval of the President
11. Adjournment

### ARTICLE III - BOARD OF DIRECTORS

SECTION I. The Board of Directors shall be composed of the captains of all teams entered in the tournament.

SECTION II. The Board of Directors shall be vested with the control and management of the annual tournament and by a majority of vote may delegate its authority in whole and in part to the executive committee.

SECTION III. The annual meeting of the Board of Directors shall be held in the tournament city during the progress of this tournament. At such a time as the President may designate and at such meetings shall elect their officers and promulgate tournament registrations for the coming years.

SECTION IV. Two-thirds of all captains entered in the tournament who shall be present at the meeting on time shall constitute a quorum. Two-thirds (2/3) of said captains, so present, may transact any and all business of Association.

SECTION V. All past presidents, vice presidents and secretary-treasurers shall be admitted to meetings as life members.

## ARTICLE IV - OFFICERS

SECTION I. The officers shall consist of a president, a vice president, a secretary-treasurer, a recording secretary, and a publicity director who will automatically represent the Executive Committee which includes the General Chairman of the pending tournament.

SECTION II. Candidates for any office except a position of the publicity director must have attended three (3) consecutive board meetings prior to nomination for officer as verified by roll call records. Any candidate for the publicity director may be a deaf or hard-of-hearing active bowler or a deaf or hard-of-hearing non-bowler who has a knowledge in the public relations field.

SECTION III. The Executive Committee may attend and vote as members of the Board of Directors at any meeting of that body, but any individual, whether he is a member of the executive committee. The Board of Directors, or members of both, may be allowed but one vote on any question at such meetings.

SECTION IV. All officers shall be elected by ballot at the meeting of the Board of Directors and they shall hold office for two (2) years. Incoming officers shall take office effective the first Monday of October following the election.

## ARTICLE V - DUTIES OF THE OFFICERS

SECTION I. The President shall preside at all meetings of the Board of Directors and Executive Committee and shall appoint an auditing committee consisting of three members: two from the tournament city and one from outside the city.

The President shall appoint all other committees as may be deemed necessary. He shall be the chief executive officer of the Association and as such enforce all the provisions and purposes hereof. Any vacancies that occur between meetings shall be filled (pro-tem) by the President until an election for the remainder of the term is held at the next meeting of the Board of Directors.

It shall be the duty of the president within sixty (60) days of assuming office to inform the Host City Chairman of the coming tournament of all expenses and related arrangements that are expected from the Host City by the Association.

SECTION II. The Vice President shall in absence of the President perform the duties of that office and shall be the Chairman of the Law Committee and Hall of Fame Committee.

SECTION III. The Secretary-Treasurer shall keep a true record of all proceedings of all meetings of the Association and of the Executive Committee in books provided for that purpose and shall keep a true record of all scores made in all tournaments held by this Association.

He shall have charge of and conduct all correspondence.

He shall open an account in a reliable bank of his residence city to be known as the DIXIE DEAF BOWLING ASSOCIATION account and shall deposit in this account all monies received from entries and revenues and distribute same on checks signed by himself. In the payment of bills and/or prizes, no check of this Association may be made out to "CASH" for any reason. At the end of tournament he shall turn over to the Executive Committee a statement showing the outcome of the tournament. This is to be done within sixty (60) days after the close of the tournament. He shall keep a true and correct account of all receipts and disbursement and make an annual report to the Board of Directors.

The Secretary-Treasurer shall be bonded for full amount of tournament fees and bank deposits at the expense of the Association Bond to be held by Active President for safekeeping.

The Secretary-Treasurer shall receive as compensation during his term in office the sum of 50 cents per man per event. This shall come from tournament expense fees.

The Secretary-Treasurer shall adhere to the following schedule.

1. mail checks for prize money within thirty (30) days after the close of the tournament.
2. Send certified letters to holders of uncashed after ninety (90) days of mailing date.
3. Ninety (90) days after certified letter has been send, revert prize money back to General Fund.



The Secretary-Treasurer is provided with the authority to set the tournament expense fee as he sees fit to meet the tournament expenses.

The Secretary-Treasurer is required to give receipts to all persons from whom money is collected. Statement of expenditures (bank) and deposits required to be submitted to Auditors.

Upon receipt of entry blanks and fees, the Secretary-Treasurer shall mail four copies of the bowling schedule of the coming tournament and the latest By-Laws to the team captains.

SECTION IV. All captains shall receive four (4) copies each of minutes of the meeting, report of receipts and expenditures, proposal blanks by the second week of October.

SECTION V. During odd-numbered years, the Secretary-Treasurer shall mail out Hall of Fame nomination form with the entry forms to all captains and Executive Board members.

SECTION VI. The Recording Secretary shall assist the Secretary-Treasurer at the annual meeting of the Board of Directors. The Recording Secretary shall make a carbon copy of the meeting in progress and leave the copy with the Secretary-Treasurer. He shall re-write minutes and mail a clean copy to the Secretary-Treasurer within thirty (30) days.

SECTION VII. The Publicity Director is responsible to publish the DDBA quarterly newsletter and mail out to the active bowlers and subscribers, and to write and send out the news releases to other deaf publications.

SECTION VII. The DDBA will pay each officers \$15.00 diem per day.

#### ARTICLE VI - HALL OF FAME COMMITTEE

SECTION I. The Hall of Fame Committee shall consist of the Vice President as the chairman and the Secretary-Treasurer.

SECTION II. The Vice President and Secretary-Treasurer shall be the only members who shall collate all information in regards to the selection of the Hall of Fame Bowler or Leader nominations before presentation to the Executive Board to be voted on.

SECTION III. The Hall of Fame Committee shall report all findings to the Executive Committee who shall constitute the nominating and voting body.

#### ARTICLE VII - AMENDMENTS

SECTION I. The Constitution, By-Laws and rules may be amended or repealed by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the members of the Board of Directors present, a quorum voting, at the annual meeting.

SECTION II. Any proposal of changes of laws or amendments must be made in writing to the Vice President thirty (30) days before tournament date.

#### ARTICLE VIII - TOURNAMENT RULES

SECTION I. The tournament shall be sanctioned and conducted according to the rules and regulations of the American Bowling Congress (ABC) unless otherwise arranged with the Congress by the Secretary-Treasurer.

SECTION II. All prizes will be awarded on a handicap, based on 70% of the difference of bowler's average and scratch being 200.

No individual's handicap shall exceed 42 pins per game in any event. Use highest ABC sanctioned average, 21 games or more from the previous season. If no average from previous season, use highest average of 21 games or more of the current season as of March 1st. If March 1st, current season average is 10 or more pins above previous season average, current average must be used. Eligible bowlers who have no acceptable average in accordance with the above rule may enter the tournament at 200 average.

Bowlers who report a lower average than required by the Association tournament rules and bowlers who do not report prize winnings of \$300.00 or more in any event in a tournament within the previous twelve month period and his actual score position and amount won to tournament official at time of entry for possible re-rating shall forfeit tournament entry fee and prize winnings.

SECTION III. Any and all complaints, protest and contentions as to scores bowled shall be made within 24 hours after the

game in question has been bowled, in writing to the Secretary-Treasurer, to be taken up with the executive committee. No changes or corrections of any kind shall be solicited or attempted otherwise.

SECTION IV. The President shall choose two (2) non-bowlers who are members of DDBA to serve with the three officers to check/verify scores of teams and all events.

SECTION V. No Professional Bowlers Association (PBA) members are allowed to participate in any event of a tournament. Former PBA members may be reinstated in the Dixie Deaf Bowling Association after two (2) years have lapsed since leaving the PBA. The separation from the PBA must be verified by a letter from a PBA officer.

SECTION VI. The head scorer during the tournament shall be a hearing man to avoid unnecessary interference by bowlers. He shall be paid a fee of \$20.00 - half of which is to be paid by the Association and half by the Host City. Scorers shall be paid up to 25 cents per line out of the tournament expense fee.

SECTION VII. The annual association tournament of four men shall bowl 3 games on Saturday and singles shall bowl 1 game on Sunday.

SECTION VIII. Scratch Masters qualifying round shall be on Saturday morning with 4 games across 8 lanes with roll-off game on Sunday afternoon, providing the Host City has a bowling establishment of 32 or more lanes. Effective 1994, team event and singles event will be bowled on all day Saturday, and the Masters tournament on all day Sunday.

SECTION X. Each bowler must wear a collar shirt. No blue jeans will be allowed to wear during the tournament.

#### ARTICLE IX - TOURNAMENT CITY

SECTION I. The city in which the annual tournament is to be held be selected four (4) years in advance by ballot at the annual meeting of Association.

SECTION II. The tournament shall be held only in the Dixie States as named in Article I, Section I.

SECTION III. Only organizations of the deaf shall sponsor or host the Association's tournament.

SECTION IV. Bidders for the tournament must submit letter of intent from clubs or association of the deaf, from hotel (headquarters), and from bowling establishment(s) at the time of bid.

SECTION V. The annual tournament shall be held during the month of May, preferably the Memorial Day weekend.

SECTION VI. Any team or sponsor submitting bid for the tournament must be a member of the Association for two (2) years prior to submitting the bid.

SECTION VII. The organization winning the bid shall deposit with the Secretary-Treasurer 25% (1/4) of the total prize money and at the same time present letters of verification from hotel and bowling establishment. Thereafter the organization shall pay 25% (1/4) of the prize money every year until paid in full (effective 1991.)

SECTION VIII. The successful bidder must send a team representative to every tournament hereafter to make a report on the program of their tournament plans.

SECTION IX. The Secretary-Treasurer shall be notified within 6 months before the date of tournament if the host unable to hold the tournament. Thereupon prize money shall be returned to the host with 50% of 1/4 prize money deposit forfeited to the Dixie Deaf Bowling Association.

#### ARTICLE X - DUTIES OF HOST

SECTION I. The General Chairman of the Tournament Committee shall submit monthly reports of its progress to the Secretary-Treasurer of this Association, beginning the first of December preceding its tournament.

SECTION II. The Host City is responsible to adapt the dates announced at the Board of Directors' meeting which will be known to all the delegates.

SECTION III. The Host City shall send out advertising matter of the forthcoming tournament sixty (60) days prior to the date of the tournament sixty (60) days prior to the date of the tournament. Guaranteed cash prizes for first place of event must be stated and placed in circulation.

SECTION IV. If the host club or organization fails to meet requirements of Section III by date, the host club/organization must pay a fine of one hundred dollars (\$100.00) to the Secretary-Treasurer with added penalty of \$25.00 of fine per week until date that advertising materials (flyers, circulars, etc.) is received through the mail by Secretary-Treasurer.

SECTION V. The organization sponsoring the tournament shall print the schedule and prize list of the tournament. Sufficient copies of these shall be supplied to the Secretary-Treasurer of the Association.

SECTION VI. The President, Vice President and Secretary-Treasurer shall be reimbursed for transportation to the tournament city at 15 cents a mile or full fare for tourist class airline seat. Three-fourth (3/4) of the expense is to borne by the Association and one-fourth by the tournament city.

SECTION VII. The host will pay for the President's room for two (2) nights. The Association and the Host will pay for Vice President's room for two (2) nights on a 50-50 basis. Dixie Deaf Bowling Association will pay the Secretary-Treasurer and the Publicity Director for their rooms for two (2) nights.

SECTION VIII. The host will pay officers' expenses on trip between tournaments if requested.

SECTION IX. The Secretary-Treasurer shall make at least one trip to the host city during the spring of the pending tournament to inspect the bowling establishment and complete any necessary business.

SECTION X. The host shall bear the expense of sleeve insignias adapted by the Association to be presented to the four members of the winning team.

SECTION XI. In event that the host club/organization fails to meet obligations outlined in Article IX and in the guidelines provided by the Secretary-Treasurer, any expenses for travel and communications made by the Secretary-Treasurer to the host club/organization or general chairman shall be billed to the host club/organization or the general chairman.

SECTION XII. Proceeds from the sale of program booklets shall become the property of the host.

SECTION XIII. The bowlers must pay their combo tickets at time they send entry fees.

SECTION XIV. The price of general admission to the alley shall be set by the host.

SECTION XV. Host must report the auditor to DDBA officers within 30 days or fine 10% interest from gross income from registration, etc.

#### ARTICLE XI - NATIONAL CRISIS

SECTION I. In event of national crisis, such as weekend closing of gas stations or gas rationing, war, etc., the host has the right to cancel the Association's tournament by February 1st.

SECTION II. The Host has the right to select another year for hosting the tournament or to have all deposits of prize money returned.

#### ARTICLE XII - HALL OF FAME NOMINATIONS

SECTION I. The Association shall have a Hall of Fame to honor and remember those bowlers and leaders whose activity has been outstanding and worthy of merit and recognition.

SECTION II. Once every two years during even numbered years the Hall of Fame Committee shall hold an election to elect one bowler and one leader to the Hall of Fame at an executive meeting before the Board of Directors meeting.

SECTION III. Nominations shall be in writing together with historical data and bowling records to the Council or Board at the annual meeting to be considered by the Hall of Fame Committee at the next Hall of Fame election.

SECTION IV. Nominations must be submitted to the Vice President at least three months prior to the election in order that he may notify other members of the committee and provide them with any data available to him.

#### Bowler Nominee Requirements

SECTION 5. Nominee must meet the following requirements as a Bowler:

- (a) Nominee must have participated in at least eight (8) tournaments of the Association to be eligible for nomination.
- (b) Nominee must have shown outstanding achievement in the Association tournaments; however, nominee's records in other sanctioned bowling tournaments and competitions hosted or sponsored by an association or bona-fide organization or bona-fide organization of the Deaf shall be considered and may be used as a basis for his nomination.
- (c) League averages, or winners of individual classics where less than sixty (60) bowlers participated and any participation in competition not sanctioned by American Bowling Congress shall not be recognized.
- (d) Request waiver of above rules by writing to the committee which may or may not make special exceptions.
- (e) Current officers of the Association are not eligible for nomination until two years have passed since they last held office. (Death or disability voids this eligibility and can be nominated.)

#### Leader Nominee Requirements

SECTION VI. Nominee must meet the following requirements as a leader:

- (a) A nominee who has demonstrated exceptional leadership and provided valuable service towards the Association for eight (8) years shall be eligible for nomination.
- (b) Request waiver of above rules by writing to the Council which may or may not make special exceptions.
- (d) Current officers of the Association are not eligible for nomination until two years have passed since they last held office. (Death or disability voids the eligibility and can be nominated.)

#### Voting Procedures

SECTION VII. Nominee in either category receiving most ballots that can be cast at election shall be declared elected.

SECTION VIII. Electors shall be entitled to three ballots for election on bowler and leader nominees.

SECTION IX. Secretary-Treasurer shall mail the ballot of three category of three ballots each with the picture of the nominees and return to the Hall of Fame committee for the final election.

SECTION X. An honorary member, elected by a three-fourths vote at the Board of Directors, shall automatically be admitted to the Hall of Fame.

SECTION XI. The plaques shall be awarded to the elected Hall of Famer.



**ARTICLE III--OFFICERS & BOARD OF DIRECTORS**

- SECTION 1:** The officers shall consist of a President, Vice-President, Secretary-Treasurer, three Board of Directors, and Hall of Fame. These seven (7) shall also serve the Executive Board.
- SECTION 2:** The President shall be elected for a term of 4 years. Term to begin right after the preceding tournament in the even year.
- SECTION 3:** The Vice-President shall, in the absence of the President perform the duties of the office Vice-President shall be elected for a term of 4 years, same as the president. She also serve as head of the Law Committee.
- SECTION 4:** The Secretary-Treasurer combined shall be elected for a term of 4 years. Term to begin as the President.
- SECTION 5:** The Recording Secretary appointed by the President at the meeting shall assist the Secretary-Treasurer at the annual meeting. The Recording secretary shall make 3 carbon copies of the minutes and leave 2 copies with the Secretary and the President. She shall type and mail a clean copy to the Secretary within 30 days.
- SECTION 6:** Any officer is not permitted to hold more than one officer. Any officer with a good reason for bowling during her term shall be allowed to remain in office.
- SECTION 7:** All officers and their duties shall be chosen to the conformance of the duties of the WIBC.
- SECTION 8:** To be eligible for officer, you must attend three (3) consecutive general meetings, prior to election.
- SECTION 9:** Any officers shall be in Board meeting. She shall be notified to one of Executive Board member. So she can be replaced by one of At-Large member.

**CONSTITUTION  
ARTICLE I -- NAMES**

- SECTION 1:** This organization shall be known as Dixie Women's Bowling Association embracing the states of Alabama, Arkansas, Florida, Georgia, Kentucky, Louisiana, Mississippi, North Carolina, South Carolina, Tennessee, Virginia, West Virginia and Maryland.
- SECTION 2:** Any other state groups wishing to do so, may have entries in the annual Tournament, but may not host.
- SECTION 3:** Whenever the DDBA adds a new state to the organization, it is automatically added to the DDWBA also.

**ARTICLE II -- OBJECTS**

- SECTION 1:** The DDWBA is formed for the following objects and purpose:
- (A) To hold, direct or under its direction and auspices, conduct and manage annually a Dixie Deaf Women's Bowling Association.
  - (B) This tournament shall determine the Dixie Champions of four (4) women's teams, individual, all events and Queens, said tournament to be governed by the Women's International Bowling Congress with such other rules as necessary not conflict herewith.
  - (C) To encourage and foster among its members, those interested in the sport, the spirit of good fellowship.

**ARTICLE IV--DUTIES OF OFFICERS**

- SECTION 1:** The President shall preside at all meetings. The President shall fill any vacancies that occur during the tournament.
- SECTION 2:** The Vice-President (Law Chairlady) shall in the absence of the President, perform the duties of that officer and preside at the Law Committee meetings, she shall read and explain all proposed changes and new amendments at the meetings.
- SECTION 3:** Secretary-Treasurer shall keep an accurate record of proceedings of all meetings; conduct all correspondence. She shall receive and deposit all monies in a bank in her hometown in the name of Dixie Deaf Women Bowling Association, which may be withdrawn only on checks by herself. Secretary-Treasurer shall keep a true and correct account of the receipts and disbursements, and shall make an annual report to the Board of Directors. Secretary-Treasurer shall distribute prizes to the captains by checks within 30 days, after close of the tournament.
- SECTION 4:** Election of #3 Board of Directors shall be held annually. #1 Director drop out upon election of #3. #2 move up to #1 spot.
- SECTION 5:** The Secretary-Treasurer shall hold bond.
- SECTION 6:** Any bowler from any state, outside of state can be come an officer after attending these consecutive tournament but her state can not host a tournament.
- SECTION 7:** Secretary-Treasurer can claim for phone bill only February 15 - May 31. President can have right call personally any or bonds.
- SECTION 8:** The Board of Directors shall consist of three (3) officers of the DDWBA and 2 member of the committee. The directors shall perform the duties of the trustee and audit the Treasurer's book annually, also serve as head scores. The Law Committee along with the Vice-President, shall oversee the proposed changes, new amendments to our constitutions and Laws.

**BY-LAWS  
ARTICLE I -- MEMBERSHIP**

- SECTION 1:** All regularly organization bowling team composed of the female sex from any state in the United States, who are deaf, partially deaf and are qualified under the rules of the WIBC are eligible from membership in this organization. A team may have any number of "hearing" bowler provided all deaf spouse (no single hearing women).
- SECTION 2:** Age limit of any women entering the DDWBA tournament shall be 18 and over. None shall be Students in schools (exclude any college).
- SECTION 3:** The hearing children of deaf parents may bowl in this tournament.
- SECTION 4:** Membership in the Dixie Deaf Women Bowling Association shall be five dollars (\$5.00) per year payable with entry fee.
- SECTION 5:** They shall be members of WIBC.
- SECTION 6:** They shall pay annual membership dues.

**ARTICLE II -- ORDER OF BUSINESS**

- SECTION 1:** The regular order of business at all meetings of the association shall be described:
- 1) Call of order
  - 2) Prayer and salute of the flag
  - 3) Roll call of Captains and Officers
  - 4) Reading of previous minutes
  - 5) Reports of Officers and communications in order
  - 6) Reports of committees--chairlady etc.
  - 7) Unfinished Business
  - 8) New Business
  - 9) Announcement of the next tournament chairlady

## ARTICLE V--AMENDMENTS

- SECTION 1:** The Constitution, By Laws and rules may be amended or repealed by a 2/3 vote of the members of the quorum voting at the annual meeting, provided that such amendments shall have been submitted in writing to Vice-President of this organization before such annual meeting of the board.
- SECTION 2:** Any proposal of changes of laws or amendments must be made in writing to the Vice-President thirty (30) days before tournament date.
- SECTION 3:** The association shall be the power to enact such by - laws as it may necessary for it's effective organization and operation.
- SECTION 4:** Constitution and By-Laws changes are to be referred to DDWBA Vice President of consideration sixty (60) days prior to the DDWBA bowler's meeting for approval.
- SECTION 5:** Discussion on the non profit organization form 501 - C3 as for the tax purpose. The Tax exemption.

## ARTICLE VI--TOURNAMENT RULES

- SECTION 1:** The tournament shall be sanctioned and conducted according to the rules and regulations of the Women International Bowling Congress (WIBC) unless otherwise arranged with the Congress by the Secretary-Treasurer.
- SECTION 2:** All prizes will be awarded on a handicap basis of 70% of 200, 45 pins per below per game limit.
- SECTION 3:** Any and all complaints, protests and constitutions as to score bowled shall be made within one hour after the game in question have been bowled, in writing to the Secretary-Treasurer to be taken up with the executive board.
- SECTION 4:** The Secretary-Treasurer is required to give receipts to all persons who send monies statements of expenditures and deposited are required to be submitted by the auditors.
- SECTION 5:** All WIBC bowlers present at the annual meeting shall have voice and can vote. Late comers into meeting can't voice. DDWBA dues must be paid before a bowler can bowl.
- SECTION 6:** All bowlers must xerox their WIBC cards and send to Secretary along with entry blanks.
- SECTION 7:** The entry fees shall be in postal money orders, express money orders, certified checks, Association checks or bank drafts (no personal check allowed) must accompany the completed entry banks. Fee less than the full amount will not be accepted.
- SECTION 8:** Any bowler who has received a prize of \$300 or more in any event of a tournament within 12 months to date of the tournament must report to the Secretary-Treasurer for possible rerate. Failure to do so can lead to forfeiture of this tournament prize.
- SECTION 9:** Secretary-Treasurer has full power to make decisions not to conflict WIBC By-Laws on tournament rules. She has the right to rerate the average if anyone shall not tell that she has won \$300 within 12 months with her sanction membership of WIBC.
- SECTION 10:** In case of a tie for first place in team event, one game roll off to determine the championships. The cost of the roll off to be paid out of the DDWBA's general fund.
- SECTION 11:** In event of a tie in singles, a 5 frame roll off for championships will be held. If still tied after 5 times--it must go on until tie is broken. Bowling fees will paid out of DDWBA's general fund.
- SECTION 12:** (A) Team shall be bowled on Saturday morning at 9 am and singles shall be bowled on Saturday afternoon at 1 pm.  
(B) Queens shall be bowled on Sunday all day. Qualifying round shall be at 9:00 am and roll off shall be at 1 pm.
- SECTION 13:** Plaques will be awarded to first place Handicap Pin Championship at said hotel on said date. This also must be the entry blanks.
- SECTION 14:** All bowlers must pay for Combo as prior the DDWBA rules also accompany the entry blanks.
- SECTION 15:** One shadow ball allowed on each lane before Team, Singles and Queen event.
- SECTION 16:** Bare midriffs, shorts, fade denim jeans, tanks, legging are not allowed. Blue jeans, Bermuda, shorts, blue jeans short above knee, Colette all by 3 inches are allowed. Bowlers who disregards this rule will be fined \$5.00
- SECTION 17:** If Blind must be used, the score will be 10 percent off her average. Her handicap remains the same.
- SECTION 18:** Special prize of \$50.00 to be awarded to any Senior Citizen over 55 years old with highest all event scores. Donated by DDWBA's general fund.
- SECTION 19:** In case of National Crisis, the Host City can have their deposit refunded. Secretary-Treasurer must be notified by February 15 of toumey year.
- SECTION 20:** The name(s) of whose are in Hall, can be eligible at meeting anytime, no matter if they are not bowlers any longer.
- SECTION 21:** Prize ratio to each 4 entries in team and single events. One (1) prize for each 10 entries in all events.
- SECTION 22:** All prize fees in this tournament will be 100 percent.
- SECTION 23:** Participants may only once in each events, if wish to bowl in queens, must enter team and singles, too.
- SECTION 24:** It shall be each bowler's responsibility to verify the accuracy of her average in handicap or classified tournaments, whether originally submitted by the bowler, her captain or others.
- SECTION 25:** Failure to use the correct average shall disqualify score if submitted average is lower than correct average thereby result in a lower classification or more handicap. Prize winnings shall be based on the submitted average if it is higher than the correct average, however, corrections in average may be permitted up to the completion of the first game of a series. WIBC Rule 319a-3
- SECTION 26:** WIBC and non-WIBC member pay participate in a Regular Sanctioned tournament with high score recognition automatically extended to WIBC members. Eligible non-league bowlers may qualify for high score recognition at their option by pay \$20.00 fee for which the Congress will issue an unattached membership card.
- SECTION 27:** Premature termination of the tournament brought about by war, national emergency or emergency causes relating thereto or there-form, fire natural disaster or any other reason beyond the control of the (name of tournament or sponsoring group) shall cause, to the extent required thereby all advertised prizes, guaranteed or otherwise, to be prorated in accordance with the number of entrants who have bowled in each of the respective events up to the time of such termination.
- SECTION 28:** Use highest WIBC sanctioned average, 21 games or more of \_\_\_\_\_ season. If no average is available for \_\_\_\_\_ use highest WIBC sanctioned average, 21 games or more as of March 1st, \_\_\_\_\_. If the \_\_\_\_\_ average is 10 or more pins above the \_\_\_\_\_ average, the current March 1st \_\_\_\_\_ average must be used. WIBC Rule 319a-2
- SECTION 29:** Bowler who have neither a current average nor an average from last year must bowl at 165 average. Any bowler who reports a lower average than required or who fails to report a prize of \$300 or more, won within the previous 12 months shall forfeit tournament entry fee and prize winnings. See below for Re-rating system.
- SECTION 30:** Between two (2) teams should be form different state at Bowling Lanes during the tournament.
- DDWBA's Re-rating System**
- SECTION 1:** (A) Pins will be added to your average: Winning must be \$300 or more per event. Within 12 months from this date-\_\_\_\_\_.

- (B) Rerate must follow by WIBC.
- (C) This rule replaces WIBC Rule 319a in our Tournaments.
- (D) The tournament and classic should report the secretary for winning prize.
- (E) All the bowlers must send secretary because record of winning money, prizes along with entry form.

## ARTICLE VII--TOURNAMENT CITY

- SECTION 1:** The city in which the annual tournament is to be held is decided by the Dixie Deaf Women Bowling Association (DDWBA). The chairlady must be a bowler or ex-bowler.
- SECTION 2:** The sponsoring host must deposit 25% (one-fourth) of the total prize money at the same time as the DDWBA receive the winning bid. The sponsor shall pay 25% 1/4 of the prize money until paid in fourth of next coming tournament. Host City will be fined \$50 after deadline on DDWBA and its deadline will be by 30th of April. Pay in full before start of the tournament which is in April.
- SECTION 3:** The Secretary-Treasurer shall be notified within six months if the tournament city is unable to hold the tournament, therefore the prize money deposit shall be forfeited and automatically turned over the next holding tournament city.
- SECTION 4:** The host city sponsoring the tournament shall print the schedule, prize list of the tournament in their program books.
- SECTION 5:** Plaques, stationery and all advertising shall be at expenses of the tournament city.
- SECTION 6:** A \$100 penalty will be imposed to Host City for not sending flyers and prizes monies when due by December.
- SECTION 7:** Entries close at midnight on a given date 45 days prior the coming tournament. No entry fees refunded unless one is replacement.
- SECTION 8:** The General Chairlady of the tournament committee shall send a scratch flyer to the Secretary in the month of December preceding the tournament.
- SECTION 9:** General Chairlady is requested to send final flyer and host reservation cards to Secretary by February 1st preceding the tournament.
- SECTION 10:** Host City is requested to pay for the President's transportation to tournament, 1/2 of this expense is to be borne by the DDWBA and 1/2 by host city.
- SECTION 11:** The Host is request to pay for Secretary-Treasurer's transportation to the tournament city; 1/2 of this expense is to be borne by the DDWBA and 1/2 by the host city. The Secretary-Treasurer shall furnish either her airline ticket or gas receipts.
- SECTION 12:** Host City is request to pay the President, Vice President and Secretary-Treasurer 's hotel room during their stay, limit 2 nights.
- SECTION 13:** Host City must send a representative or a team to the tournament to show their interest in coming tournament.
- SECTION 14:** The Secretary-Treasurer shall inform the Host City Chairlady of the coming tournament all expenses and related arrangements that are expected from the Host City by DDWBA. This shall be done in January prior to their tournament.
- SECTION 15:** Host City must see that the bowling establishing has proper arrangement for the coming tournament and a meeting room provided for ball and bag storage overnight under lock. 50 cents will be charged for overnight rental. Money goes to DDWBA General Fund.
- SECTION 16:** In event tournament acquires an uneven number of teams. Secretary shall ask Host City to form a dummy team and expenses for bowling fees shall be paid out of the DDWBA General Fund.

## ARTICLE VIII--SALARY AND EXPENSE

- SECTION 1:** (A) The Secretary-Treasurer shall receive a salary of \$10.00 per

team and \$1.00 singles on the Queen. If a tourney is not held any one year. Her salary shall be \$15.00 for that year. This is paid from the General Fund.

- (B) The Vice President and her committee (2 others) shall be paid \$10.00 each from the general fund. The recording secretary shall receive \$10.00 for the work at night.
- (C) The Board of Directors shall receive \$10.00 for their work scores.

**SECTION 2:** In event, the President or Vice President or Secretary-Treasurer stay a third night if needed, it paid by DDWBA.

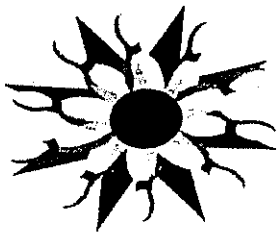
**SECTION 3:** Hall of Fame chairlady get one free night, per each committee receive.

- SECTION 6:** Hall of Fame recipient shall receive a plaque, complimentary ballroom pass and DDWBA membership card that shall permit her to attend all events.
- SECTION 7:** Chairlady will present to Bowler "Hall of Fame Plaque" at the ballroom.
- SECTION 8:** Hall of Fame received awards and can go to the meeting who pay DDWBA member fees.

## ARTICLE X--OATH OF OFFICERS
