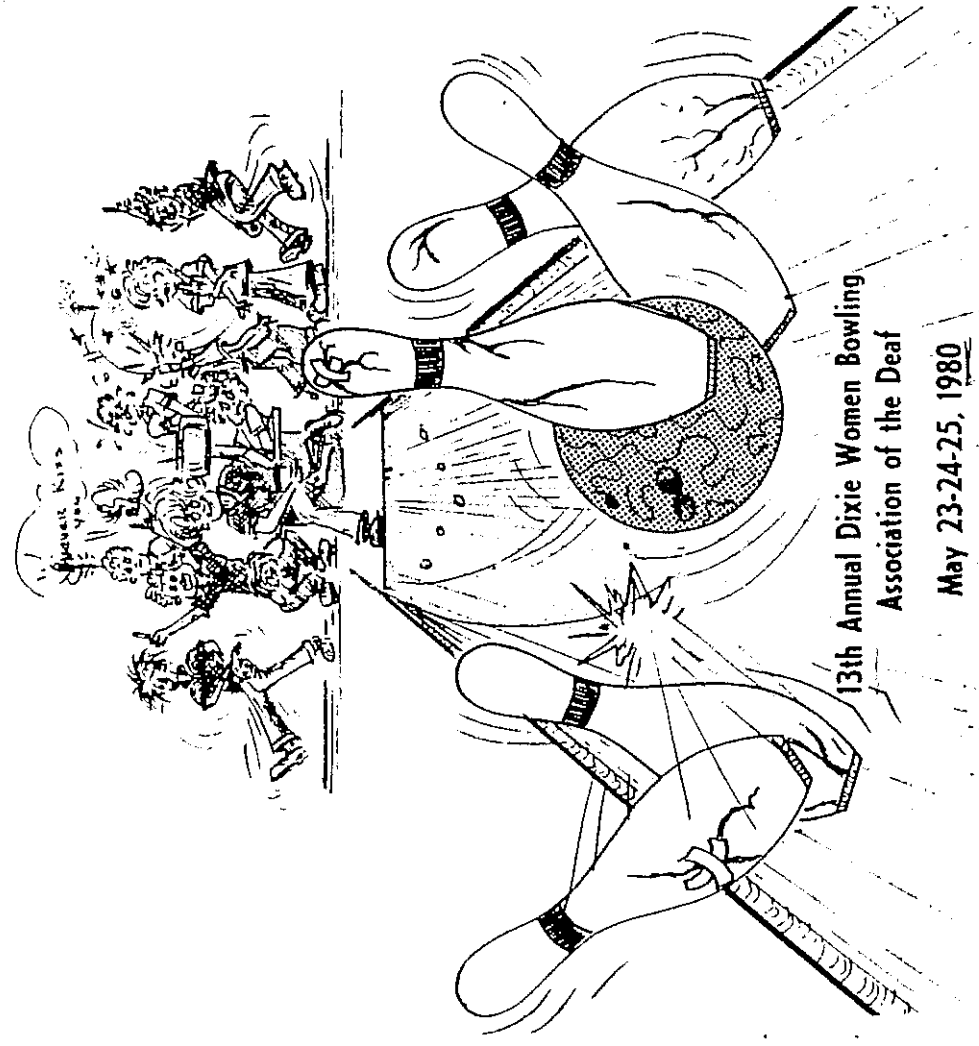

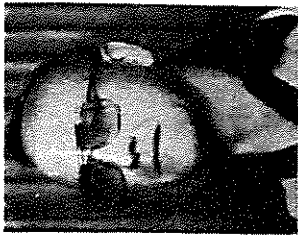

We want to thank each of you for being here and for your participation. The DBAD should be proud of its heritage which has been an inspiration to all of us.

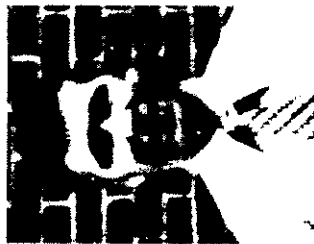
