Dial **7 1 1** to place a relay call!



Dialing 7-1-1 makes it even easier to reach Relay North Carolina!

What is 7-1-1?

7-1-1 is a telephone service that connects standard (voice) telephone users and users who are deaf, hard-of-hearing, and/or who have speech disabilities and use text telephones (TTY).

7-1-1 is easier to remember and use than traditional 800 relay numbers. It creates more user-friendly access for less experienced relay users, including businesses and friends or family members of TTY users.

Is 7-1-1 for emergencies?

7-1-1 is not an emergency number and should not be confused with 9-1-1. However, if you use a TTY and cannot obtain emergency services on 9-1-1, you may call 7-1-1 and tell the relay operator you have an emergency. The operator will then relay your call to the appropriate emergency service provider.

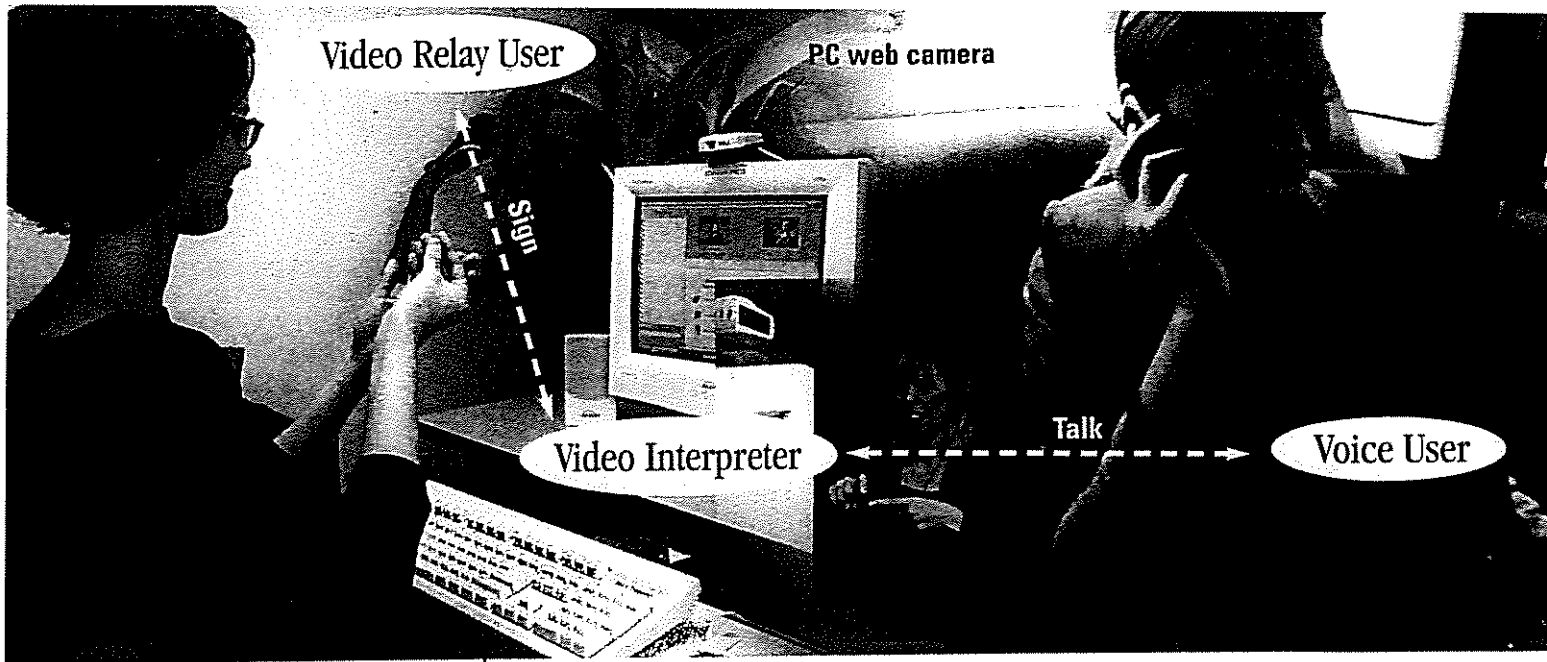

North Carolina Video Relay Service: A new communication tool for natural phone calls

Sprint and CSD are proud to offer www.rncvrs.com—the communication solution for American Sign Language (ASL) users. Video Relay Service (VRS) allows natural telephone communication between ASL and standard telephone users. This service is easily accessible from home, office, or when you are traveling. Communication flows through a qualified video interpreter via a desktop or laptop computer with video conference capability.

After connecting to www.rncvrs.com, the ASL user signs to the interpreter, who voices what he/she is saying to the other party. Emotions and facial expressions are conveyed via video, allowing both parties to be fully involved. North Carolina Video Relay Service makes phone calls *natural*—both callers are free to interrupt one another, no typing is required, no GAs needed. North Carolina Video Relay Service makes clear telephone communication a breeze!

What equipment do I need to use North Carolina Video Relay Service?

- A computer
- A web camera
- Special video software
- High speed Internet access (Cable, T-1, DSL, or ISDN)

For more information on North Carolina Video Relay Service equipment or services, contact your Sprint Relay Account Manager or visit www.rncvrs.com. In some cases, equipment needed for VRS may be available at little or no cost to you.



How does Video Relay Service work?

Video Relay calling instructions differ depending upon the type of video equipment you use to connect with the North Carolina Video Relay Service Center. Ideally, a transmission speed of 128 KBps to 384 KBps is required to display clear video images.

For Internet Video Callers

H.323 Internet: www.rncvrs.com

- H.323 uses IP (Internet Protocol) which is becoming the favorite of many deaf video users. H.323 can be used by Cable Modem, T-1 (trunk level 1), T-3, DSL (digital subscriber line) and ISDN (if done through Internet).

Making a North Carolina Video Relay Service call:

- ① Connect to www.rncvrs.com and enter your user name & password unless you have checked the box to remember your ID and Password. You need to have set up the user information database in order to set up your user ID and password.
- ② Type the number you wish to dial or select a number from the "use my phonebook" list.
- ③ Click the "Dial" link which will display a message that says: "connected to the call center".*
- ④ You should now see yourself and the video interpreter in both video boxes.
- ⑤ You may provide video interpreter with number to dial in text chat or ASL as prompted. Upon connection, begin conversation with the hearing person you have called.

* If you are an Envision or Polycom Viavideo user, when prompted, click "ready." You will see a message that says "Connecting call to NetMeeting. Please wait one moment." An "Accept" box will appear. Click on "accept".

- If your video equipment requires only one number to dial out, use any of the three numbers.
- If your video equipment requires two numbers to dial out, use any of the three numbers in both the first and second number fields.

- ① Dial 1-866-410-5787.
- ② Give Video Interpreter (VI) the IP number, the ISDN phone number(s), or name of deaf person on the ILS directory.

For VCO North Carolina VRS Callers

- ① Connect to www.rncvrs.com.
- ② Tell the Video Interpreter (VI) that you want VCO and provide the telephone number you wish to call plus your voice telephone number.
- ③ The VI will then call your voice number to connect you to the hearing person you are calling.
- ④ Speak directly to the hearing person on your voice line.
- ⑤ The VI will sign what the hearing person says to you.

Troubleshooting

- If you experience connection difficulties, visit North Carolina Video Relay Service Customer Support online at www.rncvrs.com. You can also find the technical assistance contact information in the video camera manual.
- If you use video equipment at your workplace, your video connection may be blocked because of security firewalls in Local Area Networks (LAN), which normally require the approval of the network administrator. You may contact North Carolina Video Relay Service customer support for assistance.
- You may experience occasional pauses during the video call and you may be asked to repeat your conversation to the Video Interpreter (VI) or you may need to ask the VI to inform the hearing person to repeat the conversation.

* ISDN users are not required to setup user ID and password unless preferred.

McCord Building

Through an appropriation by the General Assembly the Student Union Building was completed and opened in 1967. The building houses a large gymnasium and dressing room, bowling alley, and a large common area. The building was officially dedicated on June 13, 1970 in honor of William S. McCord of Charlotte.

THE GYMNASIUM (THE OLD GYM)

Recommendations were made to the Legislature of 1921 for an appropriation of \$10,000, together with permission to use a surplus of \$23,000 of a former bond issue, for the purpose of building a gymnasium. These requests were not granted until the session of the Legislature of 1923, and the gymnasium was completed and partially equipped by June 1924. It consisted of a swimming pool built in accord with most modern features, and a bowling alley with double "runways" and the gymnasium proper on the second floor. 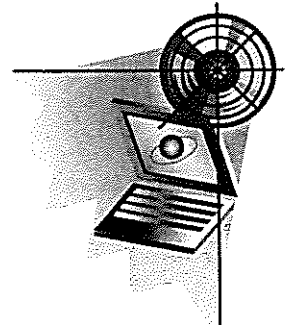

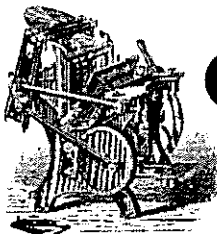

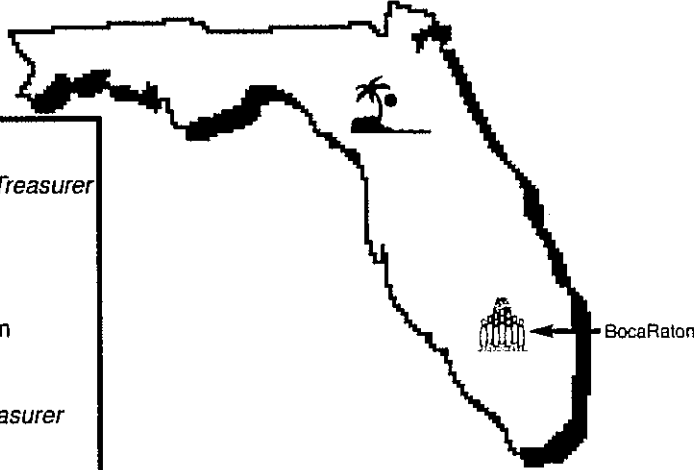
